Your tasks:

As a proven artistic personality, you will teach the entire breadth of current media art and media pedagogy under the primacy of social work theory and practice (in the BA program in Social Work as well as in the Master's program in Performative Arts in Social Fields). At the intersections with performance/formative arts, theater, and music, you will develop and teach new approaches to cultural project work in social work fields. You conceptualize interdisciplinary and project-oriented cooperations with non-university social institutions. You will implement artistic research projects in the field of tension between new media, cultural education and social work. You will manage university teaching and exchange programs with international partner universities at management level. In this context in particular, you will contribute your experience in the acquisition of third-party funding (at state, federal and EU level). You should be open to working in a multimedia-oriented BA and MA teaching team and have excellent teamwork and communication skills. You should also be willing to work intensively with staff at the university's AV Media Center. You are committed to the organization of studies and academic self-administration.

Your profile:

You have relevant scientific expertise in the field of new media, media science and history, as well as media education.

You have extensive artistic-practical experience in the fields of media art in independent and institutional contexts, in media education, in the development and implementation of cultural-pedagogical projects in diverse fields of social action, in artistic research projects and in the supervision of student projects. You have experience in conceptualizing and teaching aesthetic-media modules in social work-oriented bachelor's and master's degree programs and in supervising academic theses. You formulate a convincing teaching and research concept and bring experience in acquiring third-party funding. You can develop and implement participatory research approaches with new media in social fields (Citizen Science). You are well connected in the (regional) art and culture scene. Relevant curatorial experience (organization and design of exhibitions in artistic or scientific contexts) is an advantage.

You have a very good command of German and English.

Job requirements:

In addition to being assigned to the aforementioned faculty, the post holder will become a member of one or both of the following interdisciplinary organisational units, in which it is expected that they make a professional contribution as a member of the professorship: School of Personal Development and Education (ScoPE), which deals with the personal development of students and the specific didactics of a university of applied sciences, and/or the HoST, which strengthens interdisciplinary research as a research transfer center.

We expect our professors to:

- Be active members of our institution and to continuously support the students.
- Participate in introductory courses, i.e., teach subjects at an introductory level in all the faculty's degrees.
 - Have a predisposition and inclination to research and secure third-party funding.
 - Show gender and diversity competence.
 - Participate in the institution's international activities, including teaching in English.
 - Participate in the interdisciplinary *Studium generale*.
- Contribute to the institution's offer regarding further education, lifelong learning and e-learning.
 - Take on responsibility regarding academic self-administration.
- Be willing to pursue further training and professional development in their field of expertise and in higher education didactics.
 - Cooperate with other educational institutions in the region.
- Show commitment and initiative as expected from a performance-related position.

This is a permanent position. The first appointment as a professor is as a **public-service employee on probation or with an unlimited employment contract with a 3-year long probation period.**

The position is open to all persons, irrespective of gender.
