The holder of this position will be responsible for lecturing in the **field of "key competencies"**, within both Bachelor and Master Programs of study in the Faculty of Business and Law. Areas of specialty in the teaching activity include the conception and execution of lectures in academic key competencies in German and English: Management skills (e.g. communication, presentation, moderation, negotiation, conflict management training), social skills, intercultural communication, business ethics, (corporate) culture, future skills (e.g. data literacy) and study skills (academic writing). Special emphasis is placed on the development of innovative teaching and learning concepts.

You will also work in an interdisciplinary team of professors in **the School of Personal Development and Education (ScoPE)**. Here, interdisciplinary and cross-departmental offers are designed to promote the personal development of students. The main focus of this professorship in the ScoPE is on the areas of key competencies, personal development and general education/cultural education ("Bildungskanon").

Furthermore, we expect you to have excellent scientific and practical credentials and a degree in economics, social sciences/humanities or comparable disciplines. You have a successfully completed doctorate and teaching experience at universities (UAS). This includes in particular the areas of management skills, social skills, intercultural communication, future skills and study skills. You have experience in the didactic and methodical design and implementation of curricular and extracurricular courses.

You also gained professional experience in the field of personal development and in the application of cultural education methods ("Kulturelle Bildung") and bring openness to interdisciplinary fields. You should be able to demonstrate interdisciplinary research and publication activities in the field of key competencies, general education/Kulturelle Bildung. You are highly motivated to support and encourage our diverse students in their professional and personal development. Your own experience in the field of mindfulness and/or as an artist* is desirable.

You are asked to submit a teaching and research concept, based on the strategic direction of the department, as well as a concept for third-party funding (see also <u>www.frankfurt-university.de/Fb3-</u> <u>Bewerbung</u>). A draft of the interdisciplinary cooperation with the colleagues of the ScoPE must also be attached.
