The professorship "Organisation and Transformation of Welfare State Security Systems" is dedicated to a central topic of social policy in teaching and research: the change of social security systems and their organisation depending on social transformation processes. In this context, both the changing organization of social security systems as a whole – from the Fordist welfare state to the neoliberal welfare state – and the effects of these processes on the structures and procedures of individual organizations are significant. To convey these complex and highly dynamic structures and processes, knowledge in state theory, social theory, and not least organizational theory is required.

For the advertised position, we are seeking a professionally distinguished individual with a degree and doctorate in social sciences or related disciplines. Proven knowledge of the organisation and transformation of the German welfare state as well as European welfare state arrangements and their international context is desirable. Teaching experience at universities on the topic is desired, especially the appropriate communication of complex issues.

As the holder of the position, you will teach in the degree programs of the department that correspond to your profile. Furthermore, we expect knowledge of and experience with application-oriented methods of action as well as with theory-practice transfer.

A recognized doctorate, preferably related to the advertised teaching area, is a prerequisite. Proof of at least 5 years of professional practice, 3 years of which must be outside the university sector, or additional academic achievements with a connection to the advertised position are required. Please apply with a teaching and research concept. Experience in the acquisition of external funding is desired.

The position is available for an unlimited period of time. When first appointed to a professorship, employment is initially on a probationary civil service basis or on a permanent employment basis with a three-year probationary period.
