Students at Frankfurt University of Applied Sciences spent three months working intensively on the development and implementation of the "Welcome Harbour For **Culture and Integration**" project. The result is a 1:1 scale construction designed to complement the accommodation provided by municipal and social organisations in order to welcome refugees and create a sense of community.

Building on the aspects of sustainability - socio-cultural, economic and ecological- the project created flexible, joinable elements made from reusable and renewable materials. They can be reproduced, arranged in different ways and used as they are needed - for learning, working, playing or relaxing.

The installation was realised and documented in a new constellation. Adults, young people and children were invited to get to know each other and work together in a friendly atmosphere to design the textile equipment for the Welcome Harbour.

Specifically, the harbour needed small soft toy fish that would "travel on" with the Welcome Harbour and meet many little people in need.

In everyday university life, the six elements serve as a welcome place of learning for students on the gallery in Building 1.
